The company

- a new strategic theme in Brandenburg, facing the complex demographic problems in the health care sector (lack of skilled staff, increase of older people = clients of the system)
- based on an idea, developed in cooperation between Brandenburgs health care ministry and Adler Management
- is financed via the ESF and Brandenburgs Labour ministry
- aims to:
 - * develop a concept for training of foreign people before starting a career in the health care system in Brandenburg (academic and skilled staff)
 - * develop a coaching & consulting concept for diversity management for hospitals in Brandenburg as a support for the social and labour integration of migrants
- gives strategic support to the government regarding the future needs of support in the health care system
- aims to further-develop the partners in south Brandenburg to become innovative leaders in the health care system in the country
